



Dear Parents/Carers,

On behalf of Hampshire County Council, we have been asked to make you aware of the 'connect4communities' programme, which is providing financial support to households with food, energy and water bills this winter.

As part of the connect4communties programme, schools, early years settings and colleges have been given funding to provide Food Vouchers to families with children and those who may be struggling financially during the Christmas and February school holidays - perhaps due to loss of income because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

If you have been provided with an eVoucher, you can use it in one of Hampshire's community pantries where your money could go up to three times further than at a traditional supermarket. You can purchase a range of fresh, frozen and general foods at a lower rate each week at a community pantry.

Access to the pantry is normally through membership. However, families using their eVoucher in a community pantry will not have to pay the usual £5 weekly membership fee as part of the exchange for purchasing at least £15 worth of food and supplies.

Your voucher can also be used in a range of supermarkets.

The Food Voucher Scheme is one of several projects we have planned as part of the <u>connect4communities programme</u>. Other projects include:

- Support from Citizens Advice to help those struggling with energy and water bills
- February school holiday food and activity clubs (which includes a daily hot meal and fun, educational activities/playschemes)
- Food and fuel vouchers and slow cookers for families without basic cooking facilities available from Family Support Services and Community Pantries
- Setting up a 'connect4communities' <u>online directory</u> for residents to search by postcode to find financial and other support and subsidised food
- Supporting Community Pantries
