ACTIVITIES WEEK: 19TH - 23RD JULY 2021

This year our theme for Activities Week is the environment.

We have secured a variety of day trips that we are confident your child will enjoy and will gain a good understanding of the local environment and places to visit outdoors.

### Solar Boat trip

Pupils will have the opportunity to spend the morning looking at Chichester harbour from the water. The pupils will then come ashore for a beach walk and picnic lunch. Chichester harbour is an area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and the Harbour Conservancy team work hard to ensure that future generations learn to respect and appreciate the rich and varied habitat.

#### Moors Valley

A full day out at Moors Valley Country Park investigating the equipment and following a woodland trail through the trees. Pupils will have the opportunity to experience following signs and using maps to help reach the next location and use of play equipment.

#### Beach Clean

A half day exploring Emsworth's every changing shoreline. Pupils will take part in a safe beach clean and stop for a picnic lunch before heading back to school for further activities.

#### **Environmental Art**

Pupils will explore the local area, searching for natural items can be made into a group piece of art. Pupils will spend the morning collecting items of interest before returning to school for lunch and a workshop.
