YEAR 11 TRIP TO IMPERIAL WAR MUSEUM LONDON - MONDAY 24^{TH} FEBRUARY 2025

I would like to offer your child the opportunity to visit The Imperial War Museum in London to look at rationing and food availability during and after the war. In the spring term we will be recreating recipes and dishes of the period.

We will travel to London Victoria station by train and walk 35 minutes past sights of London to the museum. We will then return from London Victoria to Emsworth and then walk back to school in the afternoon, arriving at approximately 4.45pm which will mean that you will need to collect your child from school. I will keep parents informed of the exact pickup time.

The museum is free of charge and pupils are welcome to bring a maximum of £10 to spend on the day in the museum. Please provide your child with a packed lunch; if your child receives free school meals, lunch will be provided, however you may wish to pack extra snacks and water for the long day.

Phones will be permitted on the trip as pupils may wish to listen to music on the train.
